A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 5 of Chapter 12 of Title 44 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to disposition of unclaimed property, so as to change certain provisions relating to
- 3 when unpaid wages are deemed abandoned; to provide for voluntary reporting and delivery
- 4 of certain unpaid wages; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 5 of Chapter 12 of Title 44 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 disposition of unclaimed property, is amended by striking Code Section 44-12-206, relating
- 9 to when unpaid wages are deemed abandoned, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 10 "44-12-206.
- 11 (a) Unpaid wages, including wages represented by unpresented payroll checks owing in the
- ordinary course of the holder's business, that have remained unclaimed by the owner for
- more than one year after becoming payable are presumed abandoned.
- 14 (b) Any holder of unpaid wages, including wages represented by unpresented payroll
- 15 checks owing in the ordinary course of the holder's business, that have remained unclaimed
- by the owner for more than six months after becoming payable may voluntarily report such
- 17 <u>unpaid wages before they are presumed abandoned and be relieved of all accountability and</u>
- 18 responsibility upon delivery of such unpaid wages to the commissioner."

19 SECTION 2.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
