A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To reconstitute the Board of Commissioners of Telfair County; to provide for commissioner 2 districts; to provide for definitions and inclusions; to provide for continuation in office of 3 current members; to provide for election and terms of office of subsequent members; to 4 provide for oaths of office and surety bonds; to provide for the filling of vacancies; to 5 provide for the compensation and expenses of the chairperson and members of the board; to provide for the compensation of the clerk and other county employees; to provide for regular 6 7 and special meetings; to provide for a vice chairperson; to provide for a quorum; to provide for a clerk; to provide for formal bids for certain purchases; to provide for a superintendent 8 9 of roads and bridges; to provide for audits of county finances and financial records; to 10 provide for the powers, duties, and authority of the chairperson and members of the board; to provide for receipt of contributions for public roads and bridges; to provide for a quarterly 11 12 report for receipt and disbursement of funds; to provide for term limits; to repeal an Act approved August 27, 1931 (Ga. L. 1931, p. 566), as amended; to provide for submission of 13 14 this Act for preclearance under the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended; to 15 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

17 **SECTION 1.** The Board of Commissioners of Telfair County existing immediately prior to the effective 18 date of this Act which was created by an order of the United States District Court of the 19 Southern District of Georgia, Dublin Division, entered on October 26, 1988, in Civil Action 20 21 No. CV 387-25, as amended by subsequent orders of said court entered on December 17, 1990, in Civil Action No. CV 386-61 and August 1, 1991, in Civil Action No. CV 386-61, 22 is continued in existence but on and after the effective date of this Act, shall be constituted 23 24 as provided in this Act.

SECTION 2.

- 2 As used in this Act, the term "board," means the Board of Commissioners of Telfair County,
- 3 including the chairperson and all members.
- 4

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SECTION 3.

5 (a) Those members of the Board of Commissioners of Telfair County who are serving as 6 such immediately prior to the effective date of this Act and any person selected to fill a 7 vacancy in any such office shall continue to serve as such members until the regular 8 expiration of their respective terms of office and upon the election and qualification of their 9 respective successors. On and after the effective date of this Act, the Board of 10 Commissioners of Telfair County shall consist of five members all of whom shall be elected 11 from commissioner districts described in subsection (b) of this section.

12 (b) For purposes of electing members of the board of commissioners, Telfair County is 13 divided into five commissioner districts. One member of the board shall be elected from 14 each such district. The five commissioner districts shall be and correspond to those five 15 numbered districts described in and attached to and made a part of this Act and further 16 identified as Plan Name: telfcc2 Plan Type: Local User: linda Administrator: Telfair Co. 17 (c) When used in such attachment, the terms "Tract" and "BG" (Block Group) shall mean 18 and describe the same geographical boundaries as provided in the report of the Bureau of the 19 Census for the United States decennial census of 2000 for the State of Georgia. The separate 20 numeric designations in a Tract description which are underneath a "BG" heading shall mean 21 and describe individual Blocks within a Block Group as provided in the report of the Bureau 22 of the Census for the United States decennial census of 2000 for the State of Georgia. Any 23 part of Telfair County which is not included in any such district described in that attachment 24 shall be included within that district contiguous to such part which contains the least 25 population according to the United States decennial census of 2000 for the State of Georgia. 26 Any part of Telfair County which is described in that attachment as being in a particular 27 district shall nevertheless not be included within such district if such part is not contiguous to such district. Such noncontiguous part shall instead be included within that district 28 29 contiguous to such part which contains the least population according to the United States 30 decennial census of 2000 for the State of Georgia. Except as otherwise provided in the 31 description of any commissioner district, whenever the description of such district refers to a named city, it shall mean the geographical boundaries of that city as shown on the census 32 33 map for the United States decennial census of 2000 for the State of Georgia.

SECTION 4.

2 (a) No person shall be a member of the board if that person is ineligible for such office
3 pursuant to Code Section 45-2-1 of the O.C.G.A. or any other general law applicable to that

4 office.

5 (b) In order to be elected as a member of the board from a commissioner district, a person must receive the number of votes cast as required by general law for that office in that district 6 7 only. Only electors who are residents of that commissioner district may vote for a member of the board for that district. At the time of qualifying for election as a member of the board 8 9 from a commissioner district, each candidate for such office shall specify the commissioner 10 district for which that person is a candidate. A person elected or appointed as a member of the board from a commissioner district must attain residency in the district the person seeks 11 12 to represent at least by the time the person qualifies as a candidate for the position and must 13 continue to reside in that district during that person's term of office or that office shall 14 become vacant.

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SECTION 5.

The members of the reconstituted Board of Commissioners of Telfair County shall be elected 16 as provided in this subsection. The first members from Commissioner Districts 2, 3, and 4 17 18 shall be elected at the general election on the Tuesday next following the first Monday in 19 November, 2004. Those members of the board elected thereto from Commissioner Districts 20 2, 3, and 4 in 2004 shall take office the first day of January immediately following that 21 election and shall serve for initial terms of office which expire December 31, 2008, and upon 22 the election and qualification of their respective successors. The first members from 23 Commissioner Districts 1 and 5 shall be elected at the general election on the Tuesday next 24 following the first Monday in November, 2006. Those members of the board elected thereto 25 from Commissioner Districts 1 and 5 in 2006 shall take office the first day of January immediately following that election and shall serve for initial terms of office which expire 26 27 December 31, 2010, and upon the election and qualification of their respective successors. Those and all future successors to members of the board whose terms of office are to expire 28 29 shall be elected at the time of the state-wide general election immediately preceding the 30 expiration of such terms, shall take office the first day of January immediately following that 31 election, and shall serve for terms of office of four years each. Members of the board shall 32 serve for the terms of office specified therefor in this subsection and until their respective 33 successors are elected and qualified. 34 (b) All members of the board who are elected thereto shall be nominated and elected in

35 accordance with Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the O.C.G.A., the "Georgia Election Code."

1 (c) Commissioner Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5, as they exist immediately prior to the effective

2 date of this Act, shall continue to be designated as Commissioner Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5,

3 respectively, but as newly described under this Act, and on and after the effective date of this

4 Act, such members of the board serving from those former commissioner districts shall be

5 deemed to be serving from and representing their respective districts as newly described6 under this Act.

7 (d) Any vacancy in office upon the board which occurs for any reason shall be filled
8 pursuant to Code Section 36-5-21 of the O.C.G.A.

9

SECTION 6.

(a) The members of the board shall elect one of their number to serve as chairperson of theboard. The chairperson shall serve in that capacity at the pleasure of the board.

12 (b) At its first meeting each year, or as soon thereafter as practicable, the board shall choose

13 one of the members as vice chairperson, and such vice chairperson shall hold his or her office

14 until his or her successor is elected. Nothing in this section shall prevent the reelection of

15 any vice chairperson.

16

SECTION 7.

17 In addition to the oath required of all county officers, the commissioners shall take an 18 additional oath to perform the duties of their office truly and faithfully, to the best of their

19 skill and knowledge, and to account for all money, property, and effects of such county,

- 20 going into their possession, custody, or control and or expended by or under their direction.
- 21

SECTION 8.

22 Before entering upon the discharge of their duties, each member of the board of 23 commissioners shall give bond in the sum of \$25,000.00 except the chairperson of said board who shall give bond in the sum of \$50,000.00 with some responsible surety company 24 25 authorized to do business in Georgia, as his or her surety, payable to and approved by the judge of the probate court of the county and conditioned for the faithful performance of the 26 duties of the office and the full and true accounting for all moneys, funds, and effects of said 27 county coming into his or her hands or going into his or her custody or possession to be filed 28 29 in the office of the judge of the probate court and be there recorded and safely kept. The premiums on said bonds shall be paid by the county. 30

SECTION 9.

2 (a) The salary and expense allowance for the chairperson and the other members of the board

shall be the same as immediately prior to the effective date of this Act and may be changed
pursuant to Code Section 36-5-28 of the O.C.G.A.

5 (b) The clerk and other county employees shall be compensated in an amount to be 6 determined by the board. The board shall conduct periodic evaluations of all employees and 7 compensation of employees shall be based upon length of employment, job performance, and 8 special training or other requirements for the job.

9 (c) The total compensation to the chairperson, the county commissioners, and employees 10 shall be paid from the funds of Telfair County. No members of said board shall receive any 11 other compensation for any services or expenses incurred within the Telfair County but may 12 be reimbursed for their expenses as provided for in this subsection. Should it become 13 necessary for any member of said board to transact business for the county outside the limits of the county, then his or her expenses shall be paid out of the general funds of the county 14 15 when and only after said itemized expense account has been approved by a majority of the 16 board.

17

SECTION 10.

(a) The board shall hold at least one regular meeting each month, and the initial meeting
shall be properly advertised so that the public will be notified and may appear before the
board for any purpose. The board may conduct special meetings at any time, provided all
members of the board shall have been notified of such special meeting which shall be open
to the public.

23 (b) The vice chairperson shall, in the absence or disqualification of the chairperson or during 24 any vacancy in office of chairperson, perform and discharge all duties of the chairperson, and 25 in the event of a vacancy in the office of vice chairperson the same shall be filled by the board at its next regular meeting after such vacancy becomes known. The chairperson shall 26 27 be the chief executive of the board. He or she shall see that all orders, resolutions, and rules of the board are faithfully filled and impartially executed and enforced and that all the 28 officers, employees, and agents of said board faithfully and impartially discharge the duties 29 required of them. The chairperson shall have the general supervision of the affairs of the 30 31 county, acting under orders of the board, and shall preside at all meetings of the board. The 32 chairperson shall have the power to convene the board in extra session upon his or her own motion or upon written request of two other members of the board and shall do so whenever 33 34 two other members make such request in writing.

SECTION 11.

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Any three members of board shall constitute a quorum. The affirmative vote of three
members shall be necessary for any action by the board, and the chairperson shall have the
right to vote on all matters before the board.

SECTION 12.

The board is authorized to elect a clerk. Any citizen of the county, not a member of the 6 7 board, shall be eligible to hold the office of clerk of the board and shall receive a salary for 8 his or her services to be fixed by the board, which salary shall be paid in equal monthly 9 installments. The clerk before entering upon his or her duties shall give bond, with some 10 responsible surety company authorized to do business in Georgia, as his or her surety in the sum of \$50,000.00, to be approved by the board with the premium on such bond to be paid 11 12 by the county, payable to the judge of the probate court and his or her successors in office and conditioned for the faithful performance of his or her duties as such clerk and to account 13 14 for any and all funds, property, or effects which may come into his or her hands as such clerk 15 or otherwise, which bond shall be filed with the judge of the probate court and recorded on his or her minutes and may be sued on in like manner as the bonds of the commissioners. 16 17 The clerk shall keep minutes of all meetings of the board, an inventory of all properties, and 18 such books and records as may be required of the clerk by the board and do such other acts 19 and things as may be required of the clerk by law or by the board. The clerk shall serve at the 20 pleasure of the board.

21

SECTION 13.

22 The board, either itself or by its duly appointed agent, shall purchase all equipment, material, 23 and supplies necessary for said county, of such kind and quality and in such quantities as 24 may be needed, and, wherever practicable, purchases of all equipment, materials, and supplies shall be by competitive bids, which bids shall be kept on file in the office of the 25 board and subject to inspection by the grand jury or other interested citizens. All purchases 26 27 shall be charged to Telfair County; and before bills therefor are submitted to the board for approval, they shall be audited and payment therefor recommended by the parties making 28 such purchase; and, if approved by the board at a regular meeting of the board, such approval 29 30 shall be endorsed on such bills by the chairperson and a list thereof entered upon the minutes of the board, and when this is done warrants therefor shall be regularly drawn, which 31 32 warrants shall be signed by the chairperson and clerk as all other warrants drawn on the 33 treasury shall be signed before payment thereof is made, except that in the absence of the 34 chairperson, the vice chairperson shall be authorized to sign warrants. No purchases shall

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1 be paid for or be reimbursed by Telfair County without approval prior to purchase by the

2 board or its duly appointed purchasing agent.

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SECTION 14.

The board may at its discretion, and when it deems necessary, select a superintendent of roads and bridges. The superintendent shall give his or her entire time to said duties as such superintendent and shall not engage in any other business. The superintendent shall receive such salary as may be fixed by the board and shall hold his or her position at the pleasure of the board. The chairperson shall not be authorized to serve simultaneously as superintendent of roads and bridges.

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SECTION 15.

11 The board may have the books and accounts of the tax commissioner; custodian of all county funds; sheriff; superintendent of schools; board of commissioners; and such other officers 12 13 as may be necessary audited by a certified public accountant of this state after its takes 14 charge of the affairs of the county to cover such period as it deems advisable and every year thereafter. Such audit shall be filed in the office of the board and shall at all times be subject 15 16 to inspection by any citizen or taxpayer of the county. A summary of the audit shall be 17 published in the official organ of Telfair County within 30 days after it shall have been 18 completed.

19

SECTION 16.

20 The board shall have and it is vested with exclusive jurisdiction and control over the21 following:

- 22 (1) Directing, controlling, and caring for all the property of the county according to law;
- 23 (2) Levying taxes according to law;
- 24 (3) Establishing, altering, or abolishing public roads, private roads, private ways, bridges,
 25 and ferries, according to law;
- 26 (4) Establishing, abolishing, or changing election precincts and militia districts according
 27 to law;
- (5) Supervising the tax commissioner's books and in allowing the insolvent lists for the
 county, according to law;
- 30 (6) Settling all claims against the county; examining and auditing all claims and accounts
 31 of officers having the care, management, keeping, collecting, or disbursement of money
 32 belonging to the county or appropriating for its use or benefit and bringing them to
 33 settlement; and especially it is charged with frequently examining and auditing the books
 34 of all officers through whose hands any county funds much pass; it may require from all

- 1 such officers, subject to an examination, such reports as may be necessary to keep such 2 board fully informed at all times of the financial condition of the county; 3 (7) Controlling, caring for, and managing the convicts of the county, according to law; 4 (8) Making rules, regulations, and provisions for the support of the poor of the county, 5 according to law; (9) Promoting and preserving the public health of the county, with authority to 6 quarantine against contagious diseases and epidemics, according to law; 7 (10) Regulating and fixing license fees as may be provided by law; 8 9 (11) Bringing and defending actions in the name of Telfair County; 10 (12) Exercising the power of eminent domain in the manner described by law; (13) Generally having and exercising all powers vested previously in the former board 11 12 when sitting for county purposes; (14) Exercising such other powers as are granted by law or as may be indispensable to 13 the jurisdiction over county matters or county finance; 14 15 (15) Selecting and appointing all officers of the county whose election or appointment is not otherwise fixed by law, such as superintendent and guards and public work forces, 16 17 janitor of the court house, superintendent of the pauper farm should one be established, 18 county physician and health officer, tax assessors, and county police officers, and other 19 officers and guards as needed and authorized by law; 20 (16) Employing a competent attorney at law, resident of the county, as county attorney 21 to advise the board and represent the county in such matters as the board may direct, who 22 shall be paid such salary or compensation as the board may direct, out of the regular 23 funds of the county, with authority of the board to fix his or her term of office or to discharge him or her at any time; and 24 25 (17) Regulating peddling licenses, according to law.
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SECTION 17.

The board may receive contributions for the improvement of the public roads or bridges of the county from persons who own property along the same or from any other person or persons or from the state government or the United States government or from any corporation or firm who may be interested in the improvement of the roads and bridges, and such contributions when received shall be used for the improvement of the roads or bridges designated by the contributor.

1	SECTION 18.
2	Item 24 of the court order described in Section 1 of this Act which described certain
3	prohibited activities regarding financial interest in the sale or purchase of any article to or
4	from the county by members of the board or the clerk or receiving financial consideration
5	in connection with purchases or contracts which constituted crimes shall be of no force and
6	effect. Such matters shall be regulated as provided by general law, including, but not limited
7	to, Chapter 10 of Title 16 of the O.C.G.A. or Chapter 10 of Title 45 of the O.C.G.A.
8	
9	SECTION 19.
10	The board shall publish not less than quarterly a report for all receipts and disbursements of
11	county funds.
12	
13	SECTION 20.
14	No member of the board shall be eligible to succeed himself or herself after having served
15	two successive terms in office, nor shall any such member who is ineligible to succeed
16	himself or herself be eligible to hold any other elective county office within a four-year
17	period following the date of the expiration of his or her second successive term.
18	SECTION 21.
19	An Act creating the office of commissioner of roads and revenues for the County of Telfair,
20	approved August 27, 1931 (Ga. L. 1931, p. 566), as amended, is repealed in its entirety.
21	SECTION 22.
22	The Board of Commissioners of Telfair County shall through its legal counsel cause this Act
23	to be submitted for preclearance under the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended;
24	and such submission shall be made to the United States Department of Justice or filed with
25	the appropriate court no later than 45 days after the date on which this Act is approved by the
26	Governor or otherwise becomes law without such approval.
27	SECTION 23.

28 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
