

House Bill 751

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-5-25 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to fees  
2 for instruction permits or drivers' licenses, so as to eliminate reduced license fees regarding  
3 anatomical gifts; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 Code Section 40-5-25 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to fees for  
7 instruction permits or drivers' licenses, is amended by striking subsection (d) and inserting  
8 in its place a new subsection (d) to read as follows:

9 "(d)(1) The General Assembly finds that it is in the best interest of the state to encourage  
10 improved public education and awareness regarding anatomical gifts of human organs  
11 and tissues and to address the ever increasing need for donations of anatomical gifts for  
12 the benefit of the citizens of Georgia.

13 (2) ~~Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (2) or (3) of subsection (a) of this Code~~  
14 ~~section, each~~ Each applicant for the issuance, reissuance, or renewal of a Class C, M, A,  
15 or B driver's license ~~under paragraph (2) or (3) of subsection (a) of this Code section~~  
16 ~~shall accompany such application with a license fee as established by the commissioner,~~  
17 ~~not to exceed \$8.00, if such applicant executes~~ may execute an anatomical gift pursuant  
18 to Code Section 40-5-6.

19 (3) The department shall make available to those federally designated organ procurement  
20 organizations the name, license number, date of birth, and most recent address of any  
21 person who obtains a driver's license ~~with the reduced fee~~ and executed an anatomical  
22 gift as provided for in paragraph (2) of this subsection. Information so obtained by such  
23 organizations shall be used for the purpose of establishing a state-wide organ donor  
24 registry accessible to organ tissue and eye banks authorized to function as such in this  
25 state and shall not be further disseminated."

1 **SECTION 2.**

2 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
