A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating a new charter for the City of Stockbridge, approved April 4, 1991  
2 (Ga. L. 1991, p. 4359), as amended, so as to revise certain provisions relating to membership  
3 of elected officials on boards, commissions, and authorities; to repeal conflicting laws; and  
4 for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 An Act creating a new charter for the City of Stockbridge, approved April 4, 1991 (Ga. L.  
8 1991, p. 4359), as amended, is amended by striking subsection (d) of Section 4.11 and  
9 inserting in lieu thereof a new subsection (d) of Section 4.11, to read as follows:  
10 "(d) An elected official of the city will not be disqualified from holding an appointment  
11 to any state, county, or city board, commission, committee, or authority. An elected  
12 official of the city will not be prohibited from receiving compensation for services and  
13 reimbursement for expenses while serving on any state, county, or city board, commission,  
14 committee, or authority."

15 **SECTION 2.**

16 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
