

Senate Bill 292

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 general provisions applicable to law enforcement officers and agencies, so as to provide for
3 the creation or adoption of pursuit policies by law enforcement agencies; to provide for the
4 withholding of funding for noncompliance; to provide for related matters; to repeal
5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Chapter 1 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
9 provisions applicable to law enforcement officers and agencies, is amended by adding a new
10 Code Section 35-1-14 to read as follows:

11 "35-1-14.

12 On and after January 1, 2004, each state, county, and local law enforcement agency that
13 conducts emergency response and vehicular pursuits shall adopt written policies that set
14 forth the manner in which these operations shall be conducted. Each law enforcement
15 agency may create their own such policies or adopt an existing model. All pursuit policies
16 created or adopted by any law enforcement agency must address situations in which police
17 pursuits cross over into other jurisdictions. Law enforcement agencies which do not
18 comply with the requirements of this provision are subject to the withholding of any state
19 funding or state administered federal funding."

20 **SECTION 2.**

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
