10 attended every service; and

11 WHEREAS, in 1951, New Holland Baptist Church moved to its present location on Quarry

12 Street where it has grown to 300 members and steadfastly adheres to its mission to faithfully

13 share the gospel in northeast Georgia and around the world; and

WHEREAS, the congregation and community have been worshipfully served by a number
of pastors over the years, including Reverend D.S. Grindle, Reverend H.G. Jarrard, Sr.,
Reverend Hugh Gilbert, Dr. Bruce Morgan, Reverend W.H. Delaney, Reverend James
Brown, Reverend Richard Daley, Reverend Sam Parsons, Dr. Carl Marshall, Reverend Doyal
Conley, and current pastor Reverend Mike Taylor; and

WHEREAS, it is most appropriate that the growth and development of this great church beproperly honored and remembered as it celebrates its one-hundredth anniversary.
