A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Franklin Goldwire; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Franklin Goldwire will retire in June, 2003, from his position as principal of
3 South Effingham High School after serving 30 years in the Effingham County School
4 System; and

5 WHEREAS, he will thereafter continue to serve the public by enrolling in classes at the Air
6 War College in Montgomery, Alabama, where he will study strategic planning and joint
7 deployment as one of only 13 Air National Guardsmen admitted to such program after a
8 highly competitive selection process; and

9 WHEREAS, his 32 year military career, which both preceded and ran concurrently with his
10 career as an educator, has included service in Vietnam in 1971-1972 and his current position
11 as Inspector General of the 165th Air National Guard; and

12 WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that this dedicated and distinguished public servant
13 be recognized by this body.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
15 the members of this body commend Franklin Goldwire and extend their heartfelt thanks to
16 him for his many years of public service, both civil and military, and his contributions to the
17 welfare of his community, state, and nation.
