A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the memory of Judge Lowrey S. Stone and expressing regret at his passing; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, news of the passing of Judge Lowrey S. Stone, late of Blakely, is received with
4 deep regret by this body; and

5 WHEREAS, the life led by this distinguished gentleman of 79 years rendered his name dear
6 to the hearts of his family and fellow citizens alike; and

7 WHEREAS, he was admitted to the bar in 1947, and his legal career spanned 53 years. He
8 served as solicitor of state court, was appointed Judge of the Superior Court for the Pataula
9 Judicial Circuit by Governor George Busbee in 1981, and at the time of his death held senior
10 judge status. He was a member and past president of the Pataula Circuit Bar Association and
11 served on the Board of Governors of the State Bar of Georgia and the Council of Superior
12 Court Judges; and

13 WHEREAS, his wife of 50 years, Ann S. Stone; three children, William S. Stone, John L.
14 Stone, and Nancy S. Brown; and ten grandchildren survive him and cherish his memory; and

15 WHEREAS, while in life he commanded the esteem of his fellow citizens, in his death we
16 mingle our sympathies with the grief of his family and friends.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
18 the members of this body honor the memory of Judge Lowrey S. Stone and express their
19 regret at his passing.
