A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Marshal Ruben H. Hairston; and for other purposes.

3 of the Troup County Marshal's Department since 1990; and

5 his endeavors and whose primary concern is the welfare and safety of the citizens of Troup

16 gratitude for the unique and often unheralded contributions of local law enforcement officers
17 on behalf of the citizens of this state.
