A RESOLUTION

- 1 Expressing support for the United States Armed Forces; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the United States Armed Forces are engaged in military operations against the
3 forces of Saddam Hussein, under the code name of Operation Iraqi Freedom, in order to
4 liberate Iraq, remove Saddam Hussein from power, and neutralize Iraq's weapons of mass
5 destruction; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the brave men and women of our nation's military forces are those who pay the
7 price of freedom for our great country; and
- 8 WHEREAS, our courageous troops are now engaged in land, sea, and air combat operations
9 thousands of miles from their homes and loved ones; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the men and women who have volunteered to serve their country in its armed
11 forces deserve the highest respect and honor from their fellow citizens.
- 12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
13 hereby express this body's enduring support for the men and women of the United States
14 Armed Forces and this body's deepest thanks for their willing and courageous assumption
15 of sacrifices and hardships on behalf of their nation.
- 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate shall transmit an appropriate
17 copy of this resolution to the Adjutant General of the State of Georgia and any other
18 appropriate parties.
