6 WHEREAS, Sidney Lewis was the founder and first editor of the newspaper that survived

7 in a difficult economy under his able direction and guidance (1878-1905); and five editors

8 followed: Wales W. Thomas (1905-1906), Thomas C. Moore (1906-1914), G.B. Moore, Sr.

9 (1914-1982) Alva L. Haywood (1982-1988) and R. Allen Haywood (1988-present); and

10 WHEREAS, Hancock County's primarily agricultural community has supported past

- 11 publications of planter periodicals but prior efforts to establish and sustain a community
- 12 newspaper that covered contemporary political issues had been unsuccessful; and

WHEREAS, throughout its years, this great weekly newspaper has maintained its proud tradition covering newsworthy events with an exceptional reporting staff and its superb leadership has increased public understanding and awareness and influenced the quality of life in this historic Georgia community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that this body commends *The Sparta Ishmaelite* on the momentous occasion of its 125th
