- 4 WHEREAS, the life of this distinguished gentleman of 67 years rendered him dear to the
5 hearts of family and friends alike; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he was president and sole owner of United Health Services, Inc., a registered
7 pharmacist, and a graduate of the University of Georgia School of Pharmacy, whose business
8 evolved from a single pharmacy into a multifaceted health care organization with operations
9 in several southeastern states; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he served as president, director, and chairman of the board of the Georgia
11 Pharmaceutical Association and as president of the National Association of Retail Druggists;

- 13 WHEREAS, in addition, he participated in a wide range of civic and charitable organizations
14 and held public office as mayor of Toccoa; and
- 15 WHEREAS, he is survived by his wife of forty years, Nancy Wilkerson Pruitt, along with
16 two daughters, a son, and two grandchildren; and
- 17 WHEREAS, in life he held the esteem of his fellow citizens, and in his death we mingle our
18 sympathies with his family and friends.
