## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Alan L. Plummer, M.D.; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Alan L. Plummer, M.D., an Atlanta pulmonologist and critical care specialist,  
3 is the 148th president of the Medical Association of Georgia; and

4 WHEREAS, Dr. Plummer is chief of pulmonary diseases and critical care at Emory Clinic  
5 and Emory University Hospital and is a professor of pulmonary diseases and critical care at  
6 Emory University School of Medicine; and

7 WHEREAS, he is a graduate of Northwestern University Medical School and did his medical  
8 internship at Passavant Memorial Hospital in Chicago and completed his internal medicine  
9 residency at the Mayo Clinic, where he also did his fellowship in pulmonary diseases and  
10 critical care; and

11 WHEREAS, Dr. Plummer has been an active member of the Medical Association of Georgia  
12 for the past 25 years and served as chairperson of the board of directors from 1998 to 2001,  
13 and he is also a member of the Medical Association of Atlanta, where he served as president  
14 from 1990 to 1991; and

15 WHEREAS, Dr. Plummer is a member of the American Medical Association, and in 1996  
16 he received that association's Physician's Recognition Award with Commendation, and he  
17 has served as president of the American Lung Association of Georgia, the Georgia Thoracic  
18 Society, and the National Association of Medical Direction of Respiratory Care.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that this body commends  
20 Alan L. Plummer, M.D., for his many accomplishments and contributions.
