# A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Title 14 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to corporations, partnerships, and associations, so as to change certain provisions relating to reservation of names and filing fees for corporations, nonprofit corporations, limited partnerships, and limited liability companies; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

#### 7 **SECTION 1.** 8 Title 14 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to corporations, partnerships, and associations, is amended by striking paragraphs (1) and (6) of Code Section 14-2-122, 9 10 relating to filing fees and penalties, and inserting in lieu thereof the following: 11 12 13 **SECTION 2.** Said title is further amended by striking Code Section 14-2-402, relating to reserved 14 15 corporate names, and inserting in lieu thereof the following: 16 "14-2-402. 17 (a) A person may apply to reserve the use of a corporate name, including a fictitious name 18 for a foreign corporation whose corporate name is not available. If the Secretary of State 19 finds that the corporate name applied for is available, he shall reserve the name for the 20 applicant's use for a nonrenewable 90 day period. 21 (a) A person may apply to reserve a name for the purpose of incorporation by paying the fee specified in Code Section 14-2-122 for filing articles of incorporation. If the Secretary 22 23 of State finds that the corporate name applied for is available, he or she shall reserve the name for the applicant's use for 30 days. If the Secretary of State finds that the name 24 applied for is not distinguishable for filing purposes upon the records of the Secretary of 25

4	(b) Upon expiration of a name reservation after 30 days without the filing of articles of

6	another applicant under the same guidelines of subsection (a) of this Code section.
7	(b)(c) A person who has in effect a name reservation under subsection (a) of this Code
8	section may transfer the reservation to another person by delivering to the Secretary of
9	State a signed notice of the transfer that states the name and address of the transferee."

11	Said title is further amended by striking paragraphs (1) and (6) of Code Section 14-3-122,
12	relating to filing fees for nonprofit organizations, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

16	Said title is further amended by striking Code Section 14-3-402, relating to reservation of a
17	corporate name, and inserting in lieu the following:
18	"14-3-402.
19	(a) A person may apply to reserve the use of a corporate name, including a fictitious name
20	for a foreign corporation whose corporate name is not available. If the Secretary of State
21	finds that the corporate name applied for is available, he shall reserve the name for the
22	applicant's use for a nonrenewable 90 day period.
23	(a) A person may apply to reserve a name for the purpose of incorporation by paying the
24	fee specified in Code Section 14-3-122 for filing articles of incorporation. If the Secretary
25	of State finds that the corporate name applied for is available, he or she shall reserve the
26	name for the applicant's use for 30 days. If the Secretary of State finds that the name
27	applied for is not distinguishable for filing purposes upon the records of the Secretary of
28	State, he or she shall notify the applicant who may then submit another reservation request
29	within ten days of the date of the rejection notice without payment of an additional
30	reservation filing fee.
31	(b) Upon expiration of a name reservation after 30 days without the filing of articles of
32	incorporation, the name may again be reserved for another 30 day period by the same or

- 1 (b)(c) The owner of a reserved corporate name may transfer the reservation to another
- 2 person by delivering to the Secretary of State a signed notice of the transfer that states the
- 3 name and address of the transferee."
- 4 **SECTION 5.** 5 Said title is further amended by striking Code Section 14-9-103, relating to reservation of a limited partnership name, and inserting in lieu thereof the following: 6 7 "14-9-103. 8 (a) A person may apply to reserve the use of a limited partnership name under Code 9 Section 14-9-102. If the Secretary of State finds that the limited partnership name applied 10 for is available, he shall reserve the name for the applicant's use for a nonrenewable 90 day 11 period. 12 (a) A person may apply to reserve a name for the purpose of forming a limited partnership by paying the fee specified in Code Section 14-9-1101 for filing a certificate of limited 13 14 partnership. If the Secretary of State finds that the limited partnership name applied for is available, he or she shall reserve the name for the applicant's use for 30 days. If the 15 Secretary of State finds that the name applied for is not distinguishable for filing purposes 16 17 upon the records of the Secretary of State, he or she shall notify the applicant who may 18 then submit another reservation request within ten days of the date of the rejection notice 19 without payment of an additional reservation filing fee. 20 (b) Upon expiration of a name reservation after 30 days without the filing of a certificate 21 of limited partnership, the name may again be reserved for another 30 day period by the same or another applicant under the same guidelines of subsection (a) of this Code section. 22 23 (b)(c) A person who has in effect a name reservation under subsection (a) of this Code 24 section may transfer the reservation to another person by delivering to the Secretary of 25 State a signed notice of the transfer that states the name and address of the transferee." 26 **SECTION 6.**

Said title is further amended in Code Section 14-9-1101, relating to filing fees for limited
partnerships, by striking paragraph (1) and inserting in lieu thereof a new paragraph (1) and
by inserting at the end a new paragraph (9) to read as follows:

### **SECTION 7.**

Said title is further amended by striking Code Section 14-11-208, relating to reservation of
a limited liability company name, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

2	(a) A person may apply to reserve the use of a limited liability company name that meets
3	the requirements of subsection (a) of Code Section 14-11-207. If the Secretary of State
4	finds that the limited liability company name applied for is available, he or she shall
5	reserve the name for the applicant's use for a nonrenewable 90 day period.
6	(a) A person may apply to reserve a name for the purpose of forming a limited liability
7	company by paying the fee specified in Code Section 14-11-1101 for filing articles of
8	organization. If the Secretary of State finds that the limited liability company name applied
9	for is available, he or she shall reserve the name for the applicant's use for 30 days. If the
10	Secretary of State finds that the name applied for is not distinguishable for filing purposes
11	upon the records of the Secretary of State, he or she shall notify the applicant who may
12	then submit another reservation request within ten days of the date of the rejection notice
13	without payment of an additional reservation filing fee.
14	(b) Upon expiration of a name reservation after 30 days without the filing of articles of
15	organization, the name may again be reserved for another 30 day period by the same or
16	another applicant under the same guidelines of subsection (a) of this Code section.
17	(b)(c) A person who has in effect a name reservation under subsection (a) of this Code
18	section may transfer the reservation to another person by delivering to the Secretary of
19	State a signed notice of the transfer that states the name and address of the transferee."
20	SECTION 8.
21	Said title is further amended by striking paragraphs (1) and (9) of Code Section 14-11-1101,
22	relating to filing fees and penalties for limited liability companies, and inserting in lieu
23	thereof the following:
24	"(1) Articles of organization
25	"(9) Application for reservation of a name $\dots \dots \dots$
