A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 42 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions, and Code Section 16-6-13 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 3 relating to the penalties for violating Code Sections 16-6-9 through 16-6-12, so as to add
- 4 certain provisions for the protection of minors; to provide that persons required to register
- 5 under Code Section 42-1-12 as a result of a conviction of a crime against minors or of sexual
- 6 violence or as a result of having been declared a sexually violent predator shall not reside
- 7 within a certain proximity to schools and areas where minors congregate; to provide
- 8 definitions; to restrict certain civil and criminal liability; to provide for related matters; to
- 9 provide for penalties; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
- 10 other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 12 SECTION 1.
- 13 Chapter 1 of Title 42 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- provisions, is amended by adding a new Code Section 42-1-13 to read as follows:
- 15 "42-1-13.
- 16 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- 17 (1) 'Area where minors congregate' shall include all public and private parks and
- recreation facilities, playgrounds, skating rinks, neighborhood centers, gymnasiums, and
- similar facilities providing programs or services directed towards persons under 18 years
- of age.
- 21 (2) 'Child care facility' shall mean all public and private pre-kindergarten facilities,
- day-care centers, and preschool facilities.
- 23 (3) 'School' shall mean all public and private kindergarten, elementary, and secondary
- schools.
- 25 (b) No individual required to register under Code Section 42-1-12 shall reside within 1,000
- 26 feet of any child care facility, school, or area where minors congregate. Such distance shall

1 be determined by measuring from the outer boundary of the property on which the

- 2 individual resides to the outer boundary of the property of the child care facility, school,
- 3 or area where minors congregate at their closest points.
- 4 (c) Any person who knowingly fails to comply with the requirements of this Code section
- 5 shall be guilty of a felony and shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than one nor
- 6 more than three years.
- 7 (d) Nothing in this Code section shall create, either directly or indirectly, any civil cause
- 8 of action against or result in criminal prosecution of any person, firm, corporation,
- 9 partnership, trust, or association other than an individual required to be registered under
- 10 Code Section 42-1-12."
- 11 **SECTION 1.1.**
- 12 Code Section 16-6-13 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the penalties
- 13 for violating Code Sections 16-6-9 through 16-6-12, is amended by striking subsection (b)
- 14 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 15 "(b) A person convicted of keeping a place of prostitution, pimping, or pandering when
- such offense involves <u>keeping a place of prostitution for</u>, the pimping for, or the solicitation
- of a person under the age of 18 years to perform an act of prostitution or the assembly of
- 18 two or more persons under the age of 18 years at a fixed place for the purpose of being
- solicited by others to perform an act of prostitution shall be guilty of a felony and shall be
- 20 punished by imprisonment for a period of not less than five nor more than 20 years and
- such convicted person shall be fined not less than \$2,500.00 nor more than \$10,000.00.
- Adjudication of guilt or imposition of a sentence for a conviction of a second or subsequent
- offense of pimping or pandering involving when such offense involves keeping a place of
- 24 <u>prostitution for, the pimping for, or pandering of</u> a person under the age of 18 years
- 25 pursuant to this subsection, including a plea of nolo contendere, shall not be suspended,
- probated, deferred, or withheld."
- 27 SECTION 2.
- 28 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 29 without such approval.
- 30 **SECTION 3.**
- 31 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
