A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the Michael B. Mundy Memorial Bridge; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Michael B. Mundy was a long-time faithful public servant for the State of
3 Georgia until the day of his death; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Michael B. Mundy received a diploma from the Pickens Area Vocational
5 Technical School in Jasper, Georgia, in Drafting and Design Technology in 1970; and
- 6 WHEREAS, upon graduation, he began his professional career with the Georgia Department
7 of Transportation (DOT) in the Office of Bridge Design; and
- 8 WHEREAS, in July, 1994, Mr. Mundy received a Certificate of Grateful Appreciation from
9 DOT Commissioner Wayne Shackelford for his valuable service to the citizens of Georgia
10 going over and above his duties for the DOT in the aftermath of Tropical Storm Alberto; and
- 11 WHEREAS, in September, 1995, he received a Faithful Service Award from Governor Zell
12 Miller for 25 years of faithful service to the State of Georgia; and
- 13 WHEREAS, he continued his long and recognized career as a loyal employee of the DOT
14 for over 32 years until his death on October 3, 2002, when the State of Georgia lost a
15 distinguished citizen and faithful public servant; and
- 16 WHEREAS, it is extremely appropriate and fitting that his memory be honored in a manner
17 recognizing and honoring his contributions as a public servant of this state.
- 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 GEORGIA that the bridge over Talona Creek on State Route 515 in Pickens County is
20 designated the Michael B. Mundy Memorial Bridge.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
2 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs designating such bridge.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
4 to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to the family of Michael B. Mundy and to
5 the Department of Transportation.
