## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring Carolyn M. Ainslie; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Carolyn Ainslie has served Morgan County as County Extension Agent for  
3 Family and Consumer Sciences from January 2, 1974, to December 31, 2002, and most  
4 recently as County Extension Coordinator and Senior Public Service Associate, her  
5 dedication and time spent on behalf of Morgan County citizens being the epitome of a public  
6 servant; and

7 WHEREAS, she initiated the first Leadership Morgan County to teach and provide  
8 leadership skills to the citizens of Morgan County to help them better govern themselves and  
9 to be more informed citizens of the community; and

10 WHEREAS, she has distinguished herself among her peers as evidenced by being elected  
11 president of the Georgia Extension Association of Family and Consumer Sciences and  
12 receiving national recognition from the National Extension Association of Family and  
13 Consumer Sciences by receiving the Distinguished Service Award, the Florence Hall Award  
14 for Innovative Programming, the J. C. Penney Fellow, the Continued Excellence Award, and  
15 the Outstanding Family and Consumer Sciences Educator of the Year Award; and

16 WHEREAS, she was the first County Extension Agent to be recognized for her outstanding  
17 public service in extension outreach by receiving the Walter B. Hill Award from the  
18 University of Georgia, and also received the D. W. Brooks County Extension Agent Award  
19 of Excellence and the Outreach Award for County Extension Agent from the College of  
20 Family and Consumer Sciences; and

21 WHEREAS, she has helped to improve the health of the residents of the Lake Oconee area  
22 through classes taught in ServSafe and Walk-A-Weigh as well as continuing diabetes  
23 education; and

1 WHEREAS, she has served the community as president of the Madison-Morgan County  
2 Chamber of Commerce, as chairman of the Madison First United Methodist Church Council,  
3 as chairman of the Downtown Business Council, and as a member of numerous academic  
4 and athletic booster clubs; and

5 WHEREAS, Carolyn Ainslie is a loving mother and wife, making many sacrifices to ensure  
6 that the county operates smoothly; and

7 WHEREAS, she has been friend, companion, and great listener who has appreciably helped  
8 citizens with her counsel and advice; and

9 WHEREAS, Carolyn Ainslie's total dedication to work has contributed greatly to the  
10 desirability of Morgan County as a place to live; and

11 WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that the citizens of Georgia thank Mrs. Ainslie for  
12 her dedication, hard work, and desire to make Georgia a better place to live and work.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
14 the members of this body honor Carolyn Ainslie as an outstanding citizen and convey their
