A RESOLUTION

3 WHEREAS, on February 18, 2003, the State of Georgia lost one of its most exemplary
4 citizens upon the passing of Frank Hutcheson at the age of 85 years; and

5 WHEREAS, a native of Emanuel County, Mr. Hutcheson served as a clerk with Sanitary
6 Market and as manager of Perry's Open Air; and

7 WHEREAS, he was a faithful member and a deacon of Sardis Primitive Baptist Church; and

8 WHEREAS, he and his late wife Lucile Gentry Hutcheson were the loving parents of two
9 daughters, Nannette Radford and Annie Jo Mathis and two sons, Robert "Jimbo" Hutcheson
10 and Franklin Gentry Hutcheson; and

12 neighbors and friends; and

13 WHEREAS, it is appropriate that he be recognized and honored for a long life of dedicated
14 service to his family, his church, and his community.

16 the members of this body honor the life of Frank Hutcheson and express their sincere
17 condolences to his family.
