A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 13 of Title 44 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 exemptions from levy and sale, so as to provide a reciprocal exemption for a judgment debtor
- 3 resident in this state as against a judgment creditor resident in another state; to provide for
- 4 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 13 of Title 44 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions
- 8 from levy and sale, is amended by adding at its end a new Article 3 to read as follows:

9 "ARTICLE 3

- 10 44-13-120.
- 11 As against a judgment creditor resident in another state or an assignee or successor in
- interest to a judgment creditor resident in another state, a judgment debtor resident in
- Georgia shall be entitled to assert, in lieu of any other exemption under Georgia law, an
- exemption from levy and sale and any other process equal to the exemption which would
- be provided to the judgment debtor by the law of the state of residence of the judgment
- creditor if the judgment debtor were a resident of that state."

17 SECTION 2.

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
