A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 12-8-40.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 scrap tire disposal and storage, so as to provide that each county and municipality in the state
- 3 shall adopt and enforce an ordinance regulating the storage of used tires; to provide for
- 4 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 12-8-40.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to scrap tire
- 8 disposal and storage, is amended by striking paragraph (6) of subsection (i) and inserting in
- 9 its place a new paragraph to read as follows:
- 10 "(6) Nothing in this part shall affect the right of any Each municipality or county shall
- 11 <u>have the right and the responsibility</u> to abate or <u>and provide for the</u> clean up <u>of</u> scrap tires
- or and scrap tire materials which are a threat or potential threat to human health or the
- environment within its jurisdiction. Each county and municipality shall adopt and
- commence enforcement of an ordinance for this purpose not later than January 1, 2004.
- 15 The division may reimburse such local governments for such actions in accordance with
- procedures approved by the board."

17 SECTION 2.

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
