AS PASSED SENATE

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Part 1 of Article 2 of Chapter 10 of Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to public officials and employees doing business with the state, so as to provide a limited exception to the general prohibition against doing business with the state for certain employees of the University System of Georgia; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.** Part 1 of Article 2 of Chapter 10 of Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, 8 9 relating to public officials and employees doing business with the state, is amended by 10 adding a new Code Section 45-10-24.1 to read as follows: 11 "45-10-24.1. 12 Subsection (a) of Code Section 45-10-23 and paragraph (2) of subsection (a) of Code 13 Section 45-10-24 shall not apply to a transaction with a unit of the University System of 14 Georgia by a family owned business in which an employee of the university system or a 15 member of the employee's family has an ownership interest where all of the following 16 apply: 17 (1) The employee or one or more members of the employee's family or both have an 18 ownership interest in a family owned business, but the employee is not actively engaged 19 in the day-to-day management of the business; 20 (2) The employee is employed by a department of the unit of the university system in a 21 position below that of department head; and 22 (3) The transaction is: (A) With a unit of the university system different than the unit employing the 23 24 employee; or (B) With a department of the employing unit of the university system different than the 25 department employing the employee." 26
