AS PASSED SENATE

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 5 of Title 12 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to general provisions regarding water resources, so as to provide that the state shall
- 3 not take over operation of, condemn, or otherwise take control of locally funded water
- 4 reservoirs without paying just and adequate compensation therefor; to provide for related
- 5 matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 1 of Chapter 5 of Title 12 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 9 general provisions regarding water resources, is amended by adding a new Code Section
- 10 12-5-6 to read as follows:
- 11 "12-5-6.
- 12 Neither the state nor any of its departments, agencies, or authorities shall take over
- operation of, condemn through the exercise of the power of eminent domain, or otherwise
- 14 take control of locally funded water reservoirs without paying just and adequate
- 15 compensation therefor."

SECTION 2.

- 17 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 18 without such approval.

19 SECTION 3.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
