A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-5-54.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 denial or suspension of license for noncompliance with child support order, so as to provide
3 for the removal of the record stating that a person is not in compliance with an order for child
4 support and any record of revocation or suspension of such person's license which resulted
5 from such noncompliance upon reinstatement of such person's license; to provide for related
6 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 Code Section 40-5-54.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to denial or
10 suspension of license for noncompliance with child support order, is amended by striking
11 subsection (c) and inserting in its place the following:

12 "(c) The suspension or denial of an application for issuance or renewal of a license shall
13 be for an indefinite period and until such person shall provide proof of compliance with an
14 order for child support. Such person's license shall be reinstated if the person submits proof
15 of compliance with an order for child support from the agency or court of competent
16 jurisdiction and pays a restoration fee of \$35.00 or \$25.00 when such reinstatement is
17 processed by mail for the return of his or her license. Upon reinstatement of the person's
18 driver's license, the department shall remove the record from the agency or court stating
19 that the person was not in compliance with an order for child support and any record of
20 revocation or suspension of such person's license which resulted from such noncompliance
21 from any file that the department maintains on such person."

22 **SECTION 2.**

23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
