A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Mr. Bob Stone; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Bob Stone, founder of Systems & Methods, Incorporated, was recently honored
3 as the Citizen of the Year by the Carroll County Chamber of Commerce during the
4 organization's annual dinner in January; and

5 WHEREAS, he began his career in data processing as a student at Georgia Institute of
6 Technology and furthered his experience through employment at Lockheed Aircraft and
7 Southern Railroad. Before starting SMI, Mr. Stone served as an assistant professor of
8 business at West Georgia College in Carrollton, where he built the relationship with local
9 Department of Family and Children Services offices which gave rise to the opportunity to
10 provide a service for these struggling governmental entities across the state; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Stone built his company on solid family business ideals with a company
12 philosophy that states its employees will always "go the extra mile" for its clients, and he has
13 carried that philosophy into his community, where he has a thorough understanding of giving
14 back to the community through intense involvement in local and state civic organizations;

18 founded 32 years ago and now employs almost 250 people in offices across the nation,
