A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Alexander James Hall; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Alexander James Hall, a member of Boy Scout Troop 514 in Lawrenceville,
3 Georgia, will receive the Eagle Scout Award, the highest rank in scouting, at a Court of
4 Honor ceremony on March 30, 2003; and

5 WHEREAS, a candidate for this premier rank must complete a rigorous program of training,
6 demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques, pass his Eagle Board of Review,
7 and complete a substantial community service project; and

14 himself in a manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and

16 himself, his parents, and to Paul Rossetti, Scoutmaster of Troop 514.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
18 this body commends Alexander James Hall on attaining the rank of Eagle Scout and conveys
19 to him their congratulations and best wishes in his future pursuits.
