A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Igbo Union Atlanta; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Igbo Union Atlanta is a nonprofit organization established in 1984 by a group
3 of Igbo immigrants residing in the metropolitan Atlanta area; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the Igbo are members of an African ethnic tribe that occupies most of southeast
5 Nigeria and are said to have migrated from Israel as descendants of the biblical King
6 Solomon and Queen of Sheba; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the primary mission of Igbo Union Atlanta is to foster friendship, cultural
8 awareness, and economic cooperation among its members and the host community; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Igbo Union Atlanta supports and promotes the involvement of its members in
10 civic and charitable endeavors through cooperation and joint planning; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Igbo Union Atlanta is committed to finding ways to continually contribute to
12 the cultural and educational enrichment of the community.
- 13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
14 commend Igbo Union Atlanta for its contributions to the welfare of its members and this
15 state.
