

## House Resolution 587

## A RESOLUTION

1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to authorize the General Assembly to  
 2 provide for the allocation and dedication of revenue from the sales of special license plates  
 3 to a community greenspace preservation trust fund; to provide for related matters; to provide  
 4 for submission of this amendment for ratification or rejection; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Article III, Section IX, Paragraph VI of the Constitution is amended by adding a new  
 8 subparagraph (m) to read as follows:

9 "(m) The General Assembly may provide by general law for the allocation and dedication  
 10 of revenue derived from the sales of special and distinctive motor vehicle license plates to  
 11 a community greenspace preservation trust fund from which funds shall be disbursed for  
 12 the preservation of greenspace in populous and rapidly growing cities and counties. The  
 13 General Assembly shall be authorized to provide by law for any matters relating to the  
 14 purpose or provisions of this subparagraph. "

15 **SECTION 2.**

16 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as  
 17 provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the  
 18 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:

19 "( ) YES Shall the Constitution be amended so as to authorize the General Assembly  
 20 provide for the allocation and dedication of revenue derived from the sales  
 21 ( ) NO of special and distinctive motor vehicle license plates to a community  
 greenspace preservation trust fund?"

22 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."  
 23 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If  
 24 such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall  
 25 become a part of the Constitution of this state.
