A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 9 of Title 42 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 pardons and paroles, so as to authorize the charging and collection of a \$50.00 fee for
3 applications submitted by nonindigent adult offenders seeking to transfer their supervision
4 to another state or territory; to provide definitions; to provide an effective date; to repeal
5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Chapter 9 of Title 42 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to pardons and
9 paroles, is amended by adding at the end thereof a new Article 5 to read as follows:

10 "ARTICLE 5

11 42-9-90.

12 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:

13 (1) 'Adult' means both individuals legally classified as adults and juveniles treated as
14 adults by court order, statute, or operation of law.

15 (2) 'Offender' means an adult placed under, or subject to supervision as the result of the
16 commission of a criminal offense and released to the community under the jurisdiction
17 of courts, paroling authorities, corrections, or other criminal justice agencies.

18 (3) 'State' means a state of the United States, the District of Columbia, or any other
19 territorial possessions of the United States.

20 (b) The Department of Corrections and the State Board of Pardons and Paroles are
21 authorized to require any nonindigent adult offender to pay a \$50.00 application fee when
22 applying to transfer his or her supervision from Georgia to any other state or territory
23 pursuant to the provisions of Articles 3 and 4 of this chapter."

1 **SECTION 2.**

2 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
3 without such approval.

4 **SECTION 3.**

5 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
