A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Brendan Scott Walker; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Brendan Walker, a member of Troop 101 in Bolingbroke, Georgia, will receive
3 the Eagle Scout Award at an Eagle Court of Honor Ceremony on April 12, 2003; and
- 4 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle Scout Award has been the symbol of the highest
5 achievement among the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 6 WHEREAS, only about 4 percent of all Boy Scouts earn the Eagle Scout rank; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the attainment of this rank indicates that a Scout has developed leadership
8 ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities that will be
9 of immense benefit throughout his life; and
- 10 WHEREAS, in order for a Scout to reach this goal, he must earn 21 merit badges, 12 of
11 which are mandatory requirements for the Eagle Scout program; and
- 12 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, Brendan Walker has brought honor to himself
13 and to his family and troop.
- 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
15 Brendan Walker is recognized and commended on attaining the rank of Eagle Scout and he
16 is extended the best wishes of each member of this body for success and happiness in future
17 endeavors.
- 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
19 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Brendan Walker.
