1 Senators Brush of the 24th and Stephens of the 51st offered the following amendment:

3 Amend the Senate Education Committee substitute to SB 248 by striking lines 12 through
4 35 of page 25 and inserting in its place the following:

5 "language proficiency, and socioeconomic status and must include:

6 (1) The results of assessment instruments required under Code Section 20-2-281,
7 aggregated by grade level and subject area;

8 (2) Dropout rates for each school;

9 (3) Student attendance rates for each school;

10 (4) School completion rates for each school;

11 (5) The percentage of graduating students who attain scores on the Georgia high school
12 graduation test required under Code Section 20-2-281 that are equivalent to a passing
13 score on the test instrument until such time as the Georgia high school graduation test is
14 discontinued as provided in Code Section 20-2-281;

15 (6) The percentage of graduating students who meet the course requirements established
16 for the recommended high school program by State Board of Education rule;

17 (7) The percentage of students taking end-of-course assessment instruments under Code
18 Section 20-2-281;

19 (8) The percentage of high school students who pass the end-of-course assessment
20 instrument in core subjects; and

21 ~~(9) The results of the Scholastic Assessment Test or the ACT Assessment;~~

22 ~~(10) The percentage of students taking alternate assessments under subsection (d) of~~

24 ~~(11) The average time that a student placed in an early intervention program remains~~
25 ~~before attaining grade level status and returning to regular status; and~~

26 ~~(12)~~(9) Any other indicator the office recommends, the council approves, and the State
