A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 4A of Chapter 1 of Title 7 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to cashing checks, drafts, or money orders for consideration, so as to change the
- 3 exemption requirement for licensure for certain businesses that are engaged in check cashing;
- 4 to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 4A of Chapter 1 of Title 7 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 cashing checks, drafts, or money orders for consideration, is amended by striking paragraph
- 9 (1) of subsection (b) of Code Section 7-1-709, relating to applicability of the article, and
- 10 inserting in its place the following:
- 11 "(1) Incidental to the retail sale of goods or services for a consideration of not more than
- 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ percent of the face amount of the check, draft, or money order or $\frac{$1.00}{2.00}$ per
- 13 check, draft, or money order, whichever is greater, and where the aggregate gross income
- received by such person, partnership, association, or corporation as consideration for the
- cashing of checks does not exceed \$25,000.00 per annum for each business location; or"

SECTION 2.

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
