A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Stewart Adams; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Stewart Adams, of Powder Springs, Georgia, will receive the Eagle Scout
3 Award at an Eagle Scout Court of Honor Ceremony; and
- 4 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle Scout Award has been the symbol of the highest and most
5 prestigious achievement among the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 6 WHEREAS, only two of every 100 boys who join Cub Scouts achieve the rank of Eagle
7 Scout; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the attainment of this rank indicates that a scout has developed leadership
9 ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities that will be
10 of immense benefit throughout his life; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Stewart has distinguished himself in academics, sports, community service, and
12 scouting, achieving the rank of Eagle Scout; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Stewart has earned 21 merit badges, 12 of which are mandatory requirements
14 for the Eagle Scout program; he has held positions of leadership within his troop; he has
15 successfully completed an approved Eagle Project; and he has successfully completed an
16 Eagle Scout Board of Review; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Stewart's Eagle Project involved clearing land, planting, and landscaping in
18 order to create a butterfly garden for a homeowner's association and adding a porch swing;

- 20 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, Stewart Adams has brought honor to himself,
21 his parents, and his troop.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
2 Stewart Adams is recognized and commended on attaining the rank of Eagle Scout and he
3 is extended his community's best wishes for success and happiness in future endeavors.
