A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Charles Alfred "Chuck" Baker; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Charles Alfred "Chuck" Baker has long been recognized by the citizens of this
3 state for the vital role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to
4 quality public broadcasting; and

5 WHEREAS, he has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,
6 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his state as evidenced dramatically by his 35
7 years of superlative service in broadcasting where he taught radio and television broadcasting
8 at the University of Georgia from 1967 to 1973, served as a producer and director at
9 WSB-TV from 1973 to 1984, and embraced and championed innovative use of new
10 broadcast technology and supported education initiatives as a producer and director for
11 Georgia Public Broadcasting from 1985 to 2002; and

12 WHEREAS, his significant organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable patience
13 and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of his
14 community have earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and associates; and

15 WHEREAS, he is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
16 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

17 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
18 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 commend Charles Alfred "Chuck" Baker for his three and one-half decades of efficient,
21 effective, unselfish, and dedicated public service on behalf of broadcasting excellence in
22 Georgia.
