**AS PASSED SENATE**

**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT**

1 To amend Code Section 44-12-300 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 state recognition of American Indian tribes, so as to revise the address of one of the  
3 recognized tribes; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other  
4 purposes.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 44-12-300 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to state  
8 recognition of American Indian tribes, is amended by striking subsection (a) in its entirety  
9 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

10 "(a) The State of Georgia officially recognizes as legitimate American Indian tribes of  
11 Georgia the following tribes, bands, groups, or communities:

12 (1) The Georgia Tribe of Eastern Cherokee

16 (2) The Lower Muscogee Creek Tribe

17 Route 2, Box 370

18 Whigham, Georgia 31797; and

19 (3) The Cherokee of Georgia Tribal Council

20 Saint George, Georgia 31646."

21 **SECTION 2.**

22 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law  
23 without such approval.

**SECTION 3.**

2 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
