

House Bill 933

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 4 of Chapter 23 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
2 relating to service creditable in the Georgia Judicial Retirement System, so as to provide that
3 a member of such retirement system may obtain creditable service for prior service as a
4 county paid assistant district attorney or assistant solicitor-general; to provide for application
5 and payment of employer and employee contributions; to provide conditions and limitations;
6 to provide for an effective date and automatic repeal; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
7 purposes.

8 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

9 **SECTION 1.**

10 Article 4 of Chapter 23 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
11 service creditable in the Georgia Judicial Retirement System, is amended by inserting
12 immediately following Code Section 47-23-64 a new Code section to read as follows:

13 "47-23-65.

14 Any member of this retirement system may receive creditable service for up to three years
15 of his or her past service as a county paid assistant district attorney or assistant
16 solicitor-general upon payment to the board of trustees of the employer and employee
17 contributions based on the salary and contribution rate in effect on the date such person
18 became a member of this retirement system. Any member desiring such creditable service
19 shall make application to the board of trustees in such form as the board deems appropriate
20 and shall make payment not later than December 31, 2004, or within six months of
21 becoming a member, whichever is later. No creditable service shall be allowed under this
22 Code section for any period of employment for which creditable service is allowed under
23 any other provision of this chapter or for which creditable service is received under any
24 provision of any other public retirement or pension system of this state or of any political
25 subdivision of this state."
