A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Professor Pauline Rose Clance; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Professor Pauline Rose Clance is a distinguished member of the psychology
3 department at Georgia State University who has contributed substantially to the development
4 of one of the nation's premier graduate programs in clinical psychotherapy; and

5 WHEREAS, Dr. Clance joined the faculty at GSU in 1974 and has excelled in her various
6 academic roles as a dedicated teacher, rigorous graduate advisor, and recognized scholar
7 whose extensive research and writings have focused on the development of human potential,

13 to her exemplary career as a member of the faculty and a valued university leader, Dr. Clance
14 has an impressive psychotherapy practice and has been a treasured mentor to countless
15 doctoral students and a trusted friend to her many professional colleagues; and

16 WHEREAS, in addition to her academic career and private practice, Dr. Clance has been
17 involved in numerous community, civic, and religious organizations that seek justice and
18 equality for all and her noble efforts bring honor and credit to the university and to the state.
