2 WHEREAS, Billy Marshall of Pembroke was recently inducted into the Lions Club District
3 18B Hall of Fame in recognition of 20 years of dedication to the Lions Club; and

5 helping fund eye operations, and finding seeing eye dogs for the blind; and

12 Dyslexic; and
