1 Honoring Carolyn Ainslie; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Carolyn Ainslie has served Morgan County as County Extension Agent for
3 Family & Consumer Sciences from January 2, 1974 to December 31, 2002, and most
4 recently as County Extension Coordinator and Senior Public Service Associate; and

5 WHEREAS, she initiated the first Leadership Morgan County to teach and provide
6 leadership skills to the citizens of Morgan County to help them better govern themselves and
7 to be more informed citizens of the community; and

8 WHEREAS, she has distinguished herself among her peers as evidenced by her election as
9 President of the Georgia Extension Association of Family and Consumer Sciences and her
10 national recognition from the National Extension Association of Family and Consumer
11 Sciences by the Distinguished Service Award, the Florence Hall Award for Innovative
12 Programming, the J. C. Penney Fellow, the Continued Excellence Award, and the
13 Outstanding Family & Consumer Sciences Educator of the Year Award; and

14 WHEREAS, she was the first County Extension Agent to be recognized for her outstanding
15 public service in Extension outreach by the Walter B. Hill Award from the University of
16 Georgia, and she also received the D. W. Brooks County Extension Agent Award of
17 Excellence and the Outreach Award for County Extension Agent from the College of Family
18 and Consumer Sciences; and

19 WHEREAS, Carolyn Ainslie has helped to improve the health of the residents of the Lake
20 Oconee Area through classes taught in ServSafe and Walk-A-Weigh as well as continuing
21 diabetes education; and

22 WHEREAS, she has provided valuable leadership to the community in many ways: as
23 President of the Madison-Morgan County Chamber of Commerce; as Chairperson of the

1 Madison First United Methodist Church Council; as Chairperson of the Downtown Business
2 Council; and as a member of numerous academic and athletic booster clubs; and

3 WHEREAS, Carolyn Ainslie is a loving mother and wife; and

4 WHEREAS, she has been a friend, companion, and great listener; and citizens have
5 benefitted greatly through her counsel, advice, and expertise; and

6 WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that the citizens of Georgia thank Mrs. Ainslie for
7 her dedication, hard work, and tireless efforts to make Georgia a better place to live and
8 work.
