A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Sergeant Major Lymus Holman; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Sergeant Major Lymus Holman (U.S. Army, retired), the well-respected Junior
3 Reserved Officers Training Corps (JROTC) instructor at Hiram High School in Paulding
4 County, has been selected as the state's Army Non-Commissioned Officer JROTC Instructor
5 of the Year for the 2001-2002 school year; and

6 WHEREAS, in 1993, Sergeant Major Holman and Lt. Col. Bernard M. Booth founded
7 Paulding County's first JROTC which has taught high school students leadership skills as
8 well as physical fitness and life skills; and

9 WHEREAS, this dynamic and dedicated instructor with 27 years of active military service
10 and four years of college level teaching experience has had a positive impact on the lives of
11 more than 1,500 JROTC cadets over the past ten years; and

12 WHEREAS, in addition to his teaching duties, he also coaches the color guard, the drill team,
13 and the physical fitness team; and

14 WHEREAS, in 2002, he was selected by Atlanta's WXIA television station as the "Class Act
15 Teacher of the Week," the first JROTC instructor from the Atlanta metropolitan area to
16 receive this recognition; and

17 WHEREAS, with his hard work, leadership, and community service, he continues to be a
18 positive role model for all who know him.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
20 the members of this body congratulate Sergeant Major Lymus Holman on his selection as the
21 2001-2002 Army Non-Commissioned Officer JROTC Instructor of the Year and commend
22 him for his dedicated service to the young people of this state.
