A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of A.B.C. "Brad" Dorminy, Jr., expressing deep regret at his passing; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest natural resources conservationists and
4 most distinguished citizens September 10, 2002, with the passing of A.B.C. "Brad" Dorminy,
5 Jr.; and

6 WHEREAS, he was born April 20, 1915, in Ben Hill County, Georgia, and married the
7 former E. Myrtice Mitchell, with whom he enjoyed one son, A.B.C. "Chip" Dorminy, III, and
8 two grandchildren, Heather and A.B.C. Dorminy, IV; and

9 WHEREAS, his work as tiller of the soil and producer of food and fiber for the citizens of
10 Georgia is honored by his fellow agricultural producers; and

11 WHEREAS, his state-wide service as a member of the State Soil and Water Conservation
12 Commission from 1991-2002 inspired soil and water conservation beneficial to all of
13 Georgia's citizens and agricultural producers; and

14 WHEREAS, he served the State of Georgia in the Georgia House of Representatives for 16
15 years, serving on the Ways and Means Committee, Agriculture Committee, and as Chairman
16 of the Natural Resources Committee for 11 years; and

17 WHEREAS, his dedication to the people of Ben Hill County and the State of Georgia was
18 evident through his involvement as a District Supervisor for the Middle South Georgia Soil
19 and Water Conservation District, Director of the Georgia Forestry Association, President of
20 the Ben Hill-Irwin Tech Foundation, a Director of Fitzgerald Bank South, and as a member
21 of the Fitzgerald Rotary Club, Fitzgerald Elks Club, Fitzgerald Country Club, and
22 Fitzgerald-Ben Hill County Chamber of Commerce.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
2 remember and honor the life of A.B.C. "Brad" Dorminy, Jr., and express heartfelt regret at
3 the passing of such a devoted and honorable man.
