A RESOLUTION

1 Supporting the creation of a Law Enforcement Museum and Hall of Fame; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia has a proud and historical law enforcement heritage; and

4 WHEREAS, there is a need for a revered location for the display and archival preservation
5 of documents and artifacts that honor Georgia's law enforcement history; and

6 WHEREAS, there is a need for a revered location to educate the citizens of Georgia about
7 such topics as drug prevention and intervention, crime prevention, seatbelt and traffic safety,
8 victim assistance, and similar law enforcement topics; and

9 WHEREAS, such location should be accessible to future generations for the preservation of
10 our state's law enforcement history; and

11 WHEREAS, the Greene County Sheriff, Greene County, and the City of Greensboro have
12 conveyed an interest in and are willing to provide funding and seek funding assistance from
13 nonprofit organizations for the creation of a Georgia Law Enforcement Museum and Hall of
14 Fame.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 GEORGIA that the members of this body support the creation of a Law Enforcement
17 Museum and Hall of Fame to be located in the City of Greensboro, Greene County, Georgia.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
19 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Chris Houston, Sheriff of
20 Greene County.
