A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Dr. Norm Moye; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Dr. Norm Moye is a distinguished public administrator who contributed
3 substantially to the development of a statewide system of technical colleges in Georgia and
4 greatly expanded educational opportunities for all Georgia's adult citizens; and

5 WHEREAS, he earned his master's and doctoral degrees in education from the University
6 of Georgia and served as the Associate Director of the Center for Educational Improvement
7 from 1974 to 1980; and

8 WHEREAS, he began his career in state government as a policy analyst for the Georgia
9 General Assembly in 1981 as a member of the House Research Office; and

10 WHEREAS, he was a key staff member for Governor Joe Frank Harris' Vocational
11 Education Task Force, which recommended the creation of the State Board of Postsecondary
12 Vocational Education; and

13 WHEREAS, he was a significant resource during the legislative deliberations and enactment
14 of the statute creating the Georgia Department of Technical and Adult Education in 1988 and
15 became the Assistant Commissioner of External Affairs for the department in June, 1990
16 where he served with dedication and ability until his retirement on December 31, 2002.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
18 this body commends Dr. Norm Moye on his marvelous record of public service and conveys
19 to him their admiration and best wishes for health and happiness in his retirement.
