- 12 Vocational Education; and
- WHEREAS, he was a significant resource during the legislative deliberations and enactment
- of the statute creating the Georgia Department of Technical and Adult Education in 1988 and
- became the Assistant Commissioner of External Affairs for the department in June, 1990
- where he served with dedication and ability until his retirement on December 31, 2002.
