- 2 WHEREAS, Randy Hallman will be retiring from the Georgia Department of Transportation
3 on April 30, 2003, after 34 years of distinguished service; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he began his career during the summer of 1969 as a rear chainman and worked
5 his way up to using the transit and level, the high-tech tools for surveying at that time; and
- 6 WHEREAS, after graduating from Southern Polytechnic State University, he began working
7 in the Department of Transportation Lab at Forest Park and then transferred to the Office of
8 Urban Design where he worked for almost 29 years; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he worked on many of the "Freeing the Freeways" projects including "Spaghetti
10 Junction," the Kennedy Interchange, I-20 at Memorial Drive, I-85 from the Brookwood
11 Interchange, as well as many other high profile projects in the Metro Atlanta area; and
- 12 WHEREAS, in addition, he spent many hours in a Department of Natural Resources
13 helicopter photographing these road projects for later use in slide presentations; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Randy worked briefly in the Office of Road Design before transferring to the
15 Office of Engineering Service where his experience has been a valuable asset.
- 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
17 Randy Hallman is recognized and commended on the occasion of his retirement on April 30,
18 2003, after 34 years of admirable and valuable service to the State of Georgia and that great
