A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Buford may be said to have been "built on leather," since the Bona-Allen Leather Company, once the No. 1 saddle company in the nation and a manufacturer of shoes, collars, and baseball gloves, was formerly the premier employer in the city; and

WHEREAS, Bona-Allen of Buford was widely recognized for the quality of its work and
was the saddle maker of choice for many horse riding motion picture stars and other
celebrities, including the late Roy Rogers, who regularly traveled to Buford to obtain saddles
for his beloved Trigger; and

11 WHEREAS, the Tannery Row Merchants Association of Buford is paying tribute to the city's

12 heritage by raising funds for a life-size bronze sculpture of Roy Rogers and Trigger, to be

- 14 WHEREAS, this worthy project has been endorsed by Roy "Dusty" Rogers, Jr., who has
- 15 written in praise of the local effort; and
- 16 WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that this project be recognized by this body.

commend the City of Buford and its residents for celebrating its historical leather industry
and its connection with the late Roy Rogers.
