A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 elementary and secondary education, so as to provide for a program for preventing teen
- 3 dating violence; to provide for related matters; to delete an obsolete phrase; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to elementary and
- 8 secondary education, is amended by striking Code Section 20-2-314, relating to development
- 9 of a rape prevention and personal safety education program, and inserting in lieu thereof the
- 10 following:
- 11 "20-2-314.
- The State Board of Education shall develop, with input from appropriate experts, and such
- 13 <u>as rape crisis centers, and family violence shelters and by the start of the 2000-2001 school</u>
- 14 year, a rape prevention and personal safety education program and a program for
- preventing teen dating violence for grade eight through grade 12 which is are consistent
- with the core curriculum provided for in Code Section 20-2-140. Local boards may
- implement such a program programs at any time and for any grade level it finds <u>local</u>
- 18 <u>boards find</u> appropriate, and the state board shall encourage the implementation of such
- 19 program programs. In addition, the state board shall make information regarding such
- 20 program programs available to the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia."

21 SECTION 2.

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
