## AS PASSED SENATE

## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 31-11-53.2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 the use of automated external defibrillators by lay rescuers, so as to require the registration
- 3 of automated external defibrillators with the Georgia Department of Human Resources; to
- 4 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 31-11-53.2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the use of
- 8 automated external defibrillators by lay rescuers, is amended by inserting at the end of said
- 9 Code section a new subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 10 "(c) Any automated external defibrillators placed for use in this state must be registered
- with the Emergency Health Section of the Division of Public Health of the Department of
- Human Resources within 30 days of receipt. The Emergency Health Section of the
- Division of Public Health of the Department of Human Resources is authorized to
- promulgate rules and regulations for the placement and registry of automated external
- defibrillators in this state. Automated external defibrillators utilized by health care
- providers licensed under Title 31 or health care professionals licensed under Title 43 shall
- not be subject to this code section."

18 SECTION 2.

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
