A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the memory of Tilden Norris and expressing regret at his passing; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, news of the passing of Tilden Norris, late of St. Marys, is received with deep
4 regret by this body; and

5 WHEREAS, the life led by this distinguished gentleman of 77 years rendered his name dear
6 to the hearts of his family and fellow citizens alike; and

7 WHEREAS, in addition to his position as an executive vice president of Gilman Paper
8 Company, he served on the St. Marys city council from 1995 until his death, in which
9 capacity he contributed extensive political, community service, and leadership knowledge
10 and was a driving force behind St. Marys tourism. Furthermore, he served 22 years as a
11 member of the Camden County board of education and four years as a member of the
12 Camden County board of commissioners. He also served in leadership roles in numerous
13 civic, business, and professional organizations; and

14 WHEREAS, while in life he commanded the esteem of his fellow citizens, in his death we
15 mingle our sympathies with the grief of his family and friends.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
17 the members of this body honor the memory of Tilden Norris and express their regret at his
18 passing.
