

**ADOPTED**

1 The Senate Health and Human Services Committee offered the following amendment:

2 Amend HB 521 by striking lines 3 through 5 of page 1 and inserting in lieu thereof the  
3 following:

4 "provide information about meningococcal disease to enrolled students; to require  
5 vaccination against meningococcal disease or a signed waiver for certain students enrolled  
6 in postsecondary educational institutions; to provide that postsecondary educational  
7 institutions shall not be required to pay".

8 By striking lines 1 through 7 of page 2 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

9 "(b) In addition to the information required to be provided pursuant to subsection (a) of this  
10 Code section, a postsecondary educational institution shall provide detailed information on  
11 the risks associated with meningococcal disease and the availability, effectiveness, and  
12 known contraindications of any required or recommended vaccine against meningococcal  
13 disease to each student, or to the student's parent or guardian if the student is a minor, who  
14 has been accepted for admission.

15 (c) An individual enrolled in a postsecondary educational institution who will be residing  
16 in on-campus housing shall provide documentation of vaccination against meningococcal  
17 disease or may, if the individual is 18 years of age or older, sign a waiver provided by the  
18 institution stating that he or she has received and reviewed the information provided as  
19 required by subsections (a) and (b) of this Code section and has chosen not to be vaccinated  
20 against meningococcal disease. If the individual is a minor, his or her parent or guardian  
21 may sign the waiver provided by the institution.

22 (d) Nothing in this Code section shall be construed to require any postsecondary  
23 educational institution to provide or pay for vaccinations against meningococcal disease."
