A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Doris Mikel Tomblin; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Doris Mikel Tomblin is well known and highly respected as a dedicated teacher
3 in the Evans County School System who has significantly influenced the aspirations and
4 lives of countless students and improved the quality of life of her fellow citizens; and

5 WHEREAS, she was born in Evans County to Cora Lee Mikel and Hubert Mikel and
6 graduated in 1965 from Evans County High School where she would later return as a greatly
7 admired classroom teacher; and

8 WHEREAS, she graduated from Savannah State University in 1969 and began her teaching
9 career in the Tattnall County School System where she taught for 14 years; and

10 WHEREAS, she received her master's degree in education from Georgia Southern University
11 in 1976 and has completed 20 years of distinguished service as a teacher and administrative
12 assistant with the Evans County School System; and

13 WHEREAS, her talent, motivation, and initiative have been recognized by her colleagues
14 and superiors, and she was named the Teacher of the Year in 1989, Star Teacher in 1995, and
15 Teacher of the Month at Claxton High School in April of 2002; and

16 WHEREAS, in addition to her lifelong career in education, she is an active member of Hagan
17 Chapel Missionary Baptist Church, the director of the Miss Evans County Afro-American
18 Society Pageant for 16 years, and a member of the Evans County Recreation Department and
19 the Evans County Sisterhood for Total Change.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that this body commends
21 Doris Mikel Tomblin for her excellent public service as a dedicated classroom teacher and
22 conveys to her its appreciation and best wishes in her retirement.
